NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING TO CONSIDER 20.12.2 NMAC, BOARD OF DIRECTOR TRAINING
REQUIREMENTS

(REVISED NOTICE – December 6, 2007)

The New Mexico Environment Department will hold a public hearing at 9:00 a.m. on January 7th, 2008, and continuing thereafter as necessary, at the Marquez Building, Training Room, 525 Camino de los Marquez, Santa Fe, New Mexico to consider the Board of Director Training Requirements, 20.12.2 NMAC. The New Mexico Environment Department is the proponent of the regulation. The proposed regulation governs the training required of members of the board of directors of mutual domestic associations pursuant to the Sanitary Projects Act, Sections 3-29-1 through 3-29-21 NMSA 1978.

The proposed regulation 20.12.2 NMAC may be reviewed during regular business hours at the office of the Hearing Clerk, New Mexico Environment Department, Harold Runnels Building, 1190 St. Francis Drive, Room N-2153, Santa Fe, NM, 87505. The hearing will be conducted in accordance with 20.1.9 NMAC (Rulemaking Procedures) Environment Department, the Environmental Improvement Act, Section 74-1-9, NMSA 1978, and other applicable procedures.

Any member of the public may give oral comment or submit documents in connection with their comment at the hearing. Any member of the public who wishes to submit a written statement, in lieu of giving oral comments, may file a written statement prior to the hearing or submit it at the hearing.
