New Mexico School and Child Care Lead Testing and Reduction Program

The Water Infrastructure Improvements for the Nation Act (WIIN Act) addresses, supports, and improves America's drinking water infrastructure. Included in the WIIN Act are three drinking water grants that promote public health and protection of the environment.

1) Small, Underserved, Disadvantaged Communities Grant

This grant program provides assistance to underserved communities that have no household drinking water or wastewater services or are served by a public water system that violates or exceeds any Safe Drinking Water Act (SDWA) Maximum Containment Level, treatment technique, or action level. Funding will be awarded on a non-competitive basis to states, territories, and tribes.

2) School and Child Care Lead Testing and Reduction Grant Program

This grant program awards funding to assist local and tribal educational agencies in voluntary testing for lead contamination in drinking water at schools and childcare programs. Funding will be awarded on a non-competitive basis to states, territories, and tribes.

3) Reducing Lead in Drinking Water

This grant program is designed to facilitate reducing lead in drinking water in disadvantaged communities through infrastructure and/or treatment improvements or facility remediation in schools and childcare facilities. The goal of these projects is to address conditions that contribute to increased concentrations of lead in drinking water. Funding will be awarded on a competitive basis for all applicants other than tribes.

The New Mexico Department of Health (NMDOH), with assistance from the New Mexico Environment Department performed voluntary sampling for Lead in the Socorro Municipal Schools and the Magdalena Schools in September 2022. Sampling was conducted by student interns from New Mexico Tech and sample analysis was performed by the NMDOH Scientific Laboratory Division (SLD). The Action level for Lead in drinking water is 0.015 milligrams per liter (mg/L). The sampling results are shown on the PDF spreadsheet below. None of the sample results from the September 2022 sampling at Magdalena and Socorro Municipal Schools exceeded the 0.015mg/L action level.
