Animas Valley Water Company – Morningstar Weekly Progress Report

The following information is intended to keep customers updated on progress toward a direct connection to the City of Farmington's Drinking Water System.

1. **Boil Water Advisory still in effect**

2. *Water Conservation Measures. Customers were advised on Jun 24 thru local media to conserve water as we continue to fill our tanks. Tank levels have continued to rise due in part to water conservation. Please continue to follow the following measures:*

- a. *Please don't water lawns or fill pools*
- b. *never throw water down the drain if it can be used for a different purpose.*

3. *Farmington Interconnect. Wildflower portion of system continues to be directly connected to Farmington. A temporary pump has been installed and since July 1 has been pumping Farmington water into our upper system. As of yesterday the treatment plant has been shut down. All water is coming from Farmington. We will monitor the tank levels to see if treatment plant can remain shut down during completion of the permanent pump station.*

4. *Pump Station. The permanent pump station is under construction. The schedule is as follows with a July 22 completion date.*

- * Building Construction- Ongoing, completion expected today*
- * Piping- Completed by July 20*
- * Electrical tie in July 18-20*
- * Pump station start up July 21*

5. *Deficiency Report was concluded July 1 and is being reviewed by Souder Miller Engineers. A comprehensive water distribution map is being prepared in conjunction with Souder Miller and previous work done by Molzen Corbin Engineers.*
