Animas Valley Water Company – Morningstar Weekly Progress Report

The following information is intended to keep customers updated on progress toward a direct connection to the City of Farmington's Drinking Water System.

1. Boil Water Advisory still in effect

2. Water Conservation Measures. Please conserve water over the weekend. The tanks are relatively full. We will continue to flush lines next week.

a. Please don't water lawns or fill pools

b. never throw water down the drain if it can be used for a different purpose.

3. Farmington Interconnect. System is totally connected to Farmington since Friday July 22.

4. Pump Station. The permanent pump station is fully operational.

5. Flushing of lines have been done in Star Heights, Vista Heights, Vista North, El Poquito, Panorama, Mesa Heights, Anasazi Estates, Homestead and Town Ranches. Wildflower and County Road 3000 are currently being flushed. When flushing is finished a handout is being given to all customers pertaining to flushing your residence.

6. Deficiency Report was concluded July 1 and is being reviewed by Souder Miller Engineers. A comprehensive water distribution map is being prepared in conjunction with Souder Miller and previous work done by Molzen Corbin Engineers.

7. Notice of Violation that the Harvest Gold Subdivision water system exceeded a turbidity level of 1 NTU during the month of July 2016. Exceeding 1 NTU is a violation of 20.7.10.100 NMAC [incorporating 40 CFR Section 141.551(b)(1)].
