### Animas Valley Water Company – Morningstar Weekly Progress Report

The following information is intended to keep customers updated on progress toward a direct connection to the City of Farmington's Drinking Water System.

1. **Boil Water Advisory still in effect**

2. *Water Conservation Measures. Customers were advised on Jun 24 thru local media to conserve water as we continue to fill our tanks. Tank levels have continued to rise due in part to water conservation. **Please** continue to follow the following measures:*

- a. *Please don't water lawns or fill pools*
- b. *never throw water down the drain if it can be used for a different purpose.*

3. *Farmington Interconnect. Wildflower portion of system continues to be directly connected to Farmington. A temporary pump has been installed and since July 1 has been pumping Farmington water into our upper system.*

4. *Pump Station. The permanent pump station is under construction. The schedule is as follows with a July 15 completion date.*

Temporary Pump

- o 7/7/ 16 Begin upsizing hoses to 4 and 6 inch to increase flow*

Permanent Pump Station

- o 7/6/16: Pour concrete foundation.*
- o 7/7/16 – 7/8/16: Install pump station piping while concrete cures.*
- o 7/7/16 – 7/8/16: City of Farmington to install three phase power pole and transformer bank.*
- o 7/11/16 – 7/15/16: Ez Shade to install pump station building.*
- o 7/8/16 – 7/15/16: Four Corners Electric to install all electric services to pump station.*

5. *Deficiency Report was concluded July 1. A comprehensive water distribution map is being prepared and will be completed by July 15.*
