**Environment Department Issues Precautionary Boil Advisory
for Pinon Hills RV Park in Lincoln County, New Mexico**

(Santa Fe, NM) The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) has issued a Precautionary Boil Water Advisory for Pinon Hills RV Park in Lincoln County, New Mexico. Due to potential contamination of the water source, all consumers of the this water system are advised to boil water for five minutes before drinking, cooking and dishwashing or to use bottled water if at all possible until further notice. This advisory only applies to the drinking water at the Pinon Hills RV Park Water System, and does not extend to any of the other surrounding water systems.

The NMED is currently providing technical assistance to Pinon Hills RV Park management to correct the potential sources of contamination affecting their well.
