All community water systems are required to prepare and submit a Consumer Confidence Report to their customers as well as NMED-DWB no later than July 1st and certify that the reports were delivered by October 1st of every year. In an effort to provide assistance to Public Water Systems, the New Mexico Environment Department's Drinking Water Bureau (NMED-DWB) staff will be hosting several Consumer Confidence Report (CCR) assistance events at the locations listed below. In order to assist you in the most efficient way possible please bring as many of the following items as possible with you on the day of the event:

- Microbiological Sampling Results for the 2010 Calendar Year
- Nitrate-Nitrite Sampling Results for the 2010 Calendar Year
- Volatile Organic Compound (VOC) Sampling Results that were taken sometime during the years of 2008-2010 (benzene, vinyl chloride etc.)
- Synthetic Organic Compound (SOC) Sampling Results that were taken sometime during the years of 2008-2010 (PCB's, toxaphene, etc.)
- Heavy Metals Sampling Results that were taken sometime during the years of 2008-2010 (fluoride, cyanide, arsenic, barium, etc)
- Radiological Sampling Results that were taken sometime during the years of 2007-2010 (gross alpha, uranium, etc.)
- Lead and Copper Sampling Results that were taken sometime during the years of 2008-2010
- Chlorine residual results for the 2010 Calendar Year (if chlorination is used at your water system)
- Disinfection By-Products Sampling Results that were taken sometime during the years of 2008-2010 (if chlorination is used at your water system) (Total Trihalomethanes, Haloacetic Acids)
- Any voluntary monitoring results you wish to report
- Violation notices sent to your water system by NMED-DWB during the 2010 Calendar Year
- Copy of your source water assessment (NMED completed in 2003)
