



Free Training on Consumer Confidence Reports

All Community Water Systems are required to create a Consumer Confidence Report (CCR) each year and make this report available to customers of the water system. July 1 is the deadline for annual distribution of the CCR (covering January 1 – December 31 of previous calendar year) to customers and the State Drinking Water Bureau.

This training will explain the requirements of the CCR and then lead each participant through the process of creating the CCR. Participants will leave the training with a completed CCR ready for distribution. We will use CCR iWriter, EPA's online CCR generator, to create the report. Data for the report will be obtained from Drinking Water Watch, DWB's publicly accessible water system database.
