## **Why Should I Attend?**

This training is critical for any community public water system that:

- Is now or will be seeking funding for water projects from the state.
- Is now or will be seeking an increase in water supply from the state.
- Is seeking to improve revenues and efficiency in your system.
- Is seeking to cost-effectively increase water supplies.

A water loss control program helps control costs, may increase revenue and protects precious water resources. Any system can benefit from this **FREE** training.

## **What if I Already Have a Leak Detection Program?**

While leak detection can be an important practice, it is only one part of an overall water loss control program. This training will provide a context for the work you are already doing and help you develop a comprehensive strategy for water loss control.

## **What if I Hired Someone Who Performed An Audit For My System?**

You will benefit by understanding what goes into the audit and being able to interpret the results. It will also help you develop a strategic water loss control program.

## **How Does the Training Work?**

There are two training programs, one for small systems (less than 10,000 population) and one for large systems (greater than 10,000 population). The small system training is offered in Albuquerque, Las Cruces, and Espanola. The large system training is offered in Albuquerque. The small system training will include 4 one-day
