Topic: Water Sampling Technician Certification Workshop with SLD Field Trip Presentations

This workshop will cover water sampling requirements for compliance with the Safe Drinking Water Act (SDWA), sample site plans, sample containers, sample collection, preservation, holding times and sample form completion. The New Mexico Water Sampling Certification Study Guide will be used as the text for the class. The class will also include a field trip to the New Mexico State Scientific Laboratory, where lab personnel will cover what happens to the sample once it is delivered to the lab. The class is designed to help students prepare for the Water Sample Technician Level 1 and Level 2 exams. Five (5) classroom training hours are required for both Level 1 and Level 2 certification. The field trip is recommended for Level 2 certification for an additional five (5) training credits.
