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**RESPONSE OF PUBLIC SERVICE COMPANY OF NEW MEXICO**  
**IN SUPPORT OF PETITION FOR REGULATORY CHANGE BY THE NEW MEXICO**  
**ENVIRONMENT DEPARTMENT AND ENTRY OF APPEARANCE**

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Pursuant to 20.1.1.300.C. NMAC, Public Service Company of New Mexico (“PNM”) submits this Response in Support of the Petition for Regulatory Change filed by the New Mexico Environment Department (“NMED” or “Department”) in the above referenced mater.

**STATEMENT OF INTEREST**

This proceeding involves, among other things, a revision to the determination of Best Available Retrofit Technology (“BART”) for the San Juan Generating Station (“San Juan”). San Juan is an 1800 megawatt (nominally rated) coal-fired electric generating station located near Waterflow, New Mexico. PNM serves as the operating agent for San Juan and owns 46.7% of the facility. Other owners of San Juan include the County of Los Alamos, the City of Farmington, Tri-State Generation and Transmission Association, M-S-R Public Power Agency, the City of Anaheim, Utah Associated Municipal Power System, Southern California Public Power Authority, and Tucson Electric Power. San Juan is a significant resource in PNM’s generation portfolio.

PNM is also a party to the February 15, 2013 agreement in principle among the NMED, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency and PNM relating to the proposed alternative state

implementation plan for a revised BART determination for San Juan. Thus, PNM has a significant interest in this proceeding and PNM supports the NMED's petition as filed herein.

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
