PRODUCTS: Whole Catch Wild Alaskan Sockeye Salmon (4 oz), cold smoked and sliced (see picture below)

The recalled salmon is sold in black-and-gold, flat, rectangular vacuum-sealed packages; the lot code being recalled is **7425A2298B**. The lot code is ink-jet printed on the back of the package, on the upper left side. The UPC code is **0 99482 40880 0**. **Signage is posted in Whole Foods Market stores to notify customers of this recall.**

REGULATORY ACTION: Call Whole Foods to verify removal of product from shelves and verify that a sign has been posted for consumers (as stated in the recall notice).
