

## NOTICE OF HEARING

A Water Quality Control Commission (“Commission”) hearing has been scheduled in the matter of the Appeal of Chamisa Hills Golf and Country Club, LLC, (“Chamisa Hills”) discharge permit #1629, WQCC No. 07-07 (A) to begin following the open meeting of the Commission on December 14, 2010 and continuing thereafter as necessary. The hearing will be held in room 317 of the State Capitol Building, corner of Paseo de Peralta and Old Santa Fe Trail, Santa Fe New Mexico. The purpose of the hearing is to hear the appeal petition and settlement of the appeal between the New Mexico Environment Department and Chamisa Hills regarding Discharge Permit #1629 for Chamisa Hills.

Persons desiring to present technical testimony at the hearings must file with the Commission a written Statement of Intent to Provide Technical Testimony. The written notice shall:

- Identify the person or entity for whom technical testimony will be presented;
- Indicate whether the person filing the statement supports or opposes the settlement;
- Identify each technical witness the person intends to present and state the qualifications of that witness, including a description of their education and work background;
- Estimate the length of time each witness is expected to testify;
- Summarize or outline the direct testimony of each witness;
- List and describe, or attach, all exhibits anticipated to be offered by the person at the hearing.

The deadline for filing Statements of Intent to Provide Technical Testimony is 5:00 p.m., December 3, 2010. The Statements of Intent to Provide Technical Testimony must be filed in the Commission’s office and should reference WQCC No. 07-07 (A) and the date of the hearing. Interested Participants: Any person who wishes to be treated as an interested participant and to cross-examine witnesses at the hearing shall file and serve upon all parties an Entry of Appearance by 5:00 p.m., December 3, 2010. The filing of a Statement of Intent to Present Technical Testimony shall be considered an Entry of Appearance. The Entry of Appearance shall identify the person wishing to be treated as an interested participant, any individual who may appear on behalf of that person and the subjects they intend to address.

Participation by the General Public: Any person who has not timely filed either an Entry of Appearance or a Statement of Intent to Present Technical Testimony may present general non-technical testimony at the hearing in support of or in opposition to the Petition. Any such member may also offer exhibits, so long as the exhibit is non-technical in nature and not unduly repetitious of the testimony. A member of the public may also submit a written statement for the record prior to or during the hearing, in lieu of providing oral testimony at the hearing.
