Up to 180,000 gallons per day of reclaimed domestic wastewater from the City of Artesia Wastewater Treatment Plant (WWTP) is used to irrigate turf at an 80-acre golf course and to fill ornamental ponds. In addition, up to 4,800 gallons per day of domestic wastewater from the clubhouse, pro shop, banquet facility, restroom, and employee house is discharged to four septic tank/leachfield systems. Potential contaminants associated with this type of discharge include nitrogen compounds. The facility is located at 26th Street and Richey Avenue, Artesia, in Section 12, T17S, R25E, Eddy County. Ground water beneath the site is at a depth of approximately 165 feet and has a total dissolved solids concentration of approximately 614 milligrams per liter.	Naomi Davidson

Requests for public hearing shall be in writing and shall set forth the reasons why a hearing should be held. A hearing will be held if NMED determines that there is substantial public interest.
