On February 28, 2025 the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) received the United States Department of Energy (DOE), National Nuclear Security Administration, Los Alamos Field Office (NA-LA) and Triad National Security, LLC (Triad) (collectively referred to as the Permittees) *Class 1 Permit Modification Request for Permit Removal of the Burn Unit at Technical Area 16-399*, (Request) referenced by ESHID-603873/LA-UR-25-21148.

On August 23, 2024, DOE submitted the *Los Alamos National Laboratory Closure Certification Report for Open Burning Treatment Unit Technical Area 16-399 Burn Tray, Revision 1* (Closure Report) referenced by EPC-DO-24-223/LA-UR-24-28822, which NMED approved on November 21, 2024.

The Permittees have submitted this Request in accordance with the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR), Title 40, 270.42(a)(2), and Permit Section 3.1(3) for a Class 1 permit modification requiring prior approval. NMED has reviewed the Request and determined that it conforms with 40 CFR 270.42 Appendix I Item A.8 to remove permit conditions that are no longer applicable and Item A.1 for administrative changes. NMED has reviewed the Request and finds the submittal administratively complete. NMED has updated the Los Alamos National Laboratory Hazardous Waste Facility Permit (Permit) to incorporate the changes described in the Request by modifying the Permit to remove interim status TA-16-399 from Permit Attachments B and J. An electronic version of the Permit that incorporates the approved

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modification will be sent to the Permittees via email and the modified Permit will also be available on the NMED Hazardous Waste Bureau's website at:
