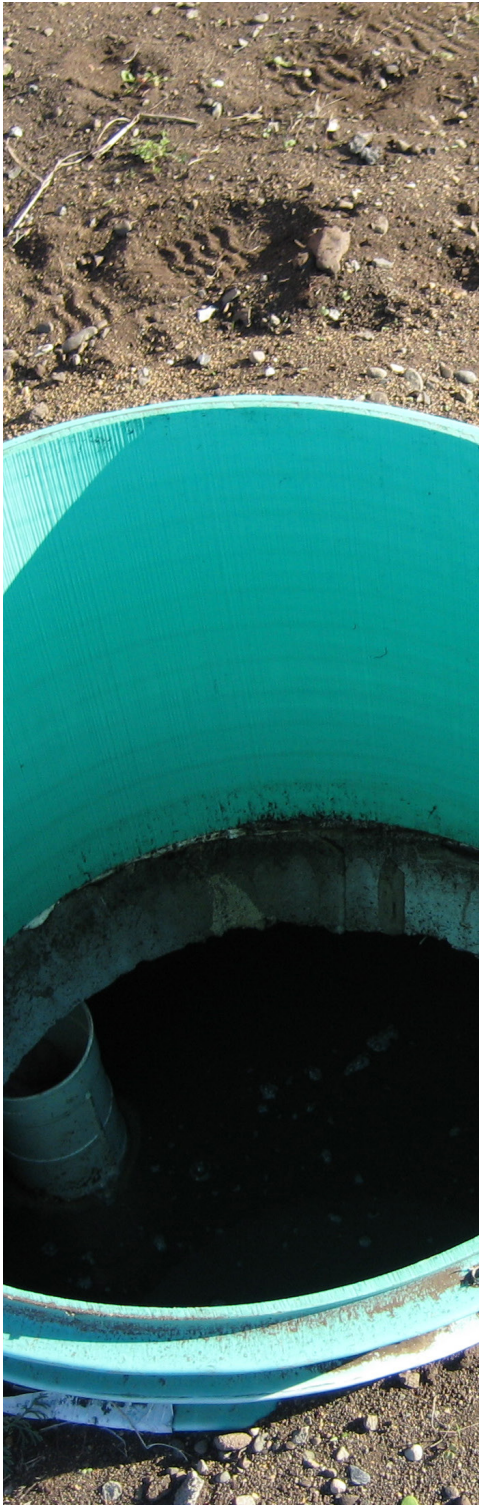


# Septic System Operation and Maintenance—Private Well Owners and Environmental Health Professionals
