Adjustment of OHSB Civil Penalties

Purpose

The penalty information included in this Appendix is intended to supplement the penalty information found in Chapter 6 of the New Mexico Field Operations Manual. The tables included in this Appendix reflect penalty amounts effective April 1, 2025.

Background

[Senate Bill 229](#) ("SB 229"), signed into law on April 6, 2017, amended the Occupational Health and Safety Act to adjust maximum and minimum penalties in conformance with Federal law. See NMSA 1978, § 50-9-24(J). The legislation conformed to the requirements of the Federal Occupational Safety and Health Act, the FCPAA, and Federal OSHA rules for approval of State occupational health and safety plans.

SB 229 also amended the Occupational Health and Safety Act, NMSA 1978, Section 50-9-24(J), requiring the Cabinet Secretary of the Environment Department to adjust penalty levels on an annual basis.

Minimum and Maximum Penalties

Pursuant to NMSA 1978, Section 50-9-24(J) for annual penalty adjustments, the maximum and minimum penalty amounts listed herein are amended as provided in Table 6A below.
