MOTION TO CURE JURISDICTIONAL INFIRMITY IN ORDER TO AVOID UNDUE DELAY

New Energy Economy, the Center for Biological Diversity, and WildEarth Guardians ("Movants"), hereby respectfully request¹ that the Water Quality Control Commission ("WQCC") cancel the hearing scheduled in this matter to begin on May 13, 2024, dismiss this case, that each commissioner file the financial disclosures required under NMSA 1978, § 74-6-3(B), and that NMED, in consultation with stakeholders, reissue a proposed rule and petition for hearing. As grounds, Movants state:

- 1. On or about December 27, 2023 the Water Protection Division of the New Mexico Environment Department ("Department") filed a Petition with the Water Quality Control Commission ("WQCC" or "Commission") to adopt a new part ("Part 8") to Title 20, Chapter 6 of the New Mexico Administrative Code ("NMAC").
- 2. On January 9, 2024, a meeting of the WQCC was held. The recording of that meeting is available at https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=_XGtu7p9Jcw. The following

Commissioner members were in attendance: Chair Bruce Thomson, Vice Chair Jonas

Armstrong, and members William Brancard, Keith Candelaria, Srikanth Paladugu, Bonnie Frey,

Gerry Razatos, Edward Vigil, Larry Dominguez, Krista McWilliams and Katie Zemlick.

Commission members Kirk Patten and Toby Velasquez were not present. The members of the

Commission voted on the Petition filed by the Department. Member Brancard moved to

schedule the hearing and appoint a hearing officer, which was seconded by Member Vigil. This

motion passed on a 9-2 vote of the present members of the Commission. Commissioners

Dominguez and McWilliams voted against.

- 3. In accordance with the approved motion, Bruce Thomson, as Chair of the WQCC, issued an Order Designating Hearing Officer (attached hereto as *Exhibit 1*) on January 25, 2024 that:
 - a) designated Ms. Felicia Orth as Hearing Officer to conduct the proceedings;
 - b) granted the Hearing Officer all powers and duties prescribed or delegated by the Commission under the Water Quality Act, NMSA 1978, Sections 74-6-1 to -17 and 20.1.6.100 NMAC; and
 - c) ordered the Hearing Officer to issue a scheduling order setting the date, time, and location of a hearing.
- 4. Water Quality Control Commissioners are required, upon the acceptance of the member's appointment and prior to the performance of any of the member's duties, to file a financial disclosure statement with the New Mexico Secretary of State under the Water Quality Act. NMSA 1978 § 74-6-3(B). This subsection requires commissioners to submit a financial disclosure statement "prior to the performance of any of the member's duties." The full text of Section 74-6-3(B) states:
 - B. A member of the commission shall not receive, or shall not have received during the previous two years, a significant portion of the member's income directly or indirectly from permit holders or applicants for a permit. A member of the commission shall, upon the acceptance of the member's appointment and prior to the performance of any of the

member's duties, file a statement of disclosure with the secretary of state disclosing any amount of money or other valuable consideration, and its source, the value of which is in excess of ten percent of the member's gross personal income in each of the preceding two years, that the member received directly or indirectly from permit holders or applicants for permits required under the Water Quality Act. A member of the commission shall not participate in the consideration of an appeal if the subject of the appeal is an application filed or a permit held by an entity that either employs the commission member or from which the commission member received more than ten percent of the member's gross personal income in either of the preceding two years.

(emphasis added). Until the financial disclosure statement is filed with the Secretary of State, a WQCC member is not permitted to perform any of the member's duties. Thus, actions taken after a WQCC member's appointment but prior to filing a financial disclosure with the Secretary of State are unlawful and void.

- 5. The following appointed WQCC members, who voted on the motion to hold a hearing in this matter on January 9, 2024, failed to file their respective financial disclosure after their appointment and *prior* to making the decision on January 9, 2024 to hold a hearing in this matter and appoint a Hearing Officer:
 - a) Chairman Bruce Thomson. Despite being appointed on April 19, 2023 (retroactive to January 1, 2023), *see Exhibit 2*, Chairman Thomson did not file a financial disclosure statement with the Secretary of State until April 30, 2024. *See Exhibit 3*. He previously filed a financial disclosure statement on January 19, 2021, but that was for a prior appointment.
 - b) Vice Chair Jonas Armstrong. Despite being appointed on March 28, 2023, *see Exhibit 4*, Vice Chair Armstrong did not file a financial disclosure statement with the Secretary of State until January 11, 2024. *See Exhibit 5*. He previously filed a financial disclosure statement on January 17, 2023, but that was for a prior appointment.
 - c) William Brancard. Despite being appointed on May 1, 2023, *see Exhibit 6*, Commissioner Brancard did not file a financial disclosure statement with the Secretary of State until January 21, 2024. *See Exhibit 7*.
 - d) Keith Candelaria. Despite being appointed on April 19, 2023 (retroactive to January 1, 2023), see *Exhibit 8*, Commissioner Candelaria has not filed a financial disclosure statement with the Secretary of State since the appointment. He previously filed a financial disclosure statement on January 30, 2021, but that was for a prior appointment.

- e) Paladugu Srikanth. Despite being appointed on June 15, 2023, *see Exhibit 9*, Commissioner Paladugu has not filed a financial disclosure statement with the Secretary of State since the appointment.
- f) Larry Dominguez: It is unknown when Commissioner Dominguez was appointed, but he has never filed a financial disclosure statement with the Secretary of State.
- g) Bonnie Frey. Despite being appointed on July 14, 2022 (effective August 1, 2022), see *Exhibit 10*, Commissioner Frey did not file a financial disclosure statement with the Secretary of State until March 4, 2024. See *Exhibit 11*.
- h) Krista McWilliams. Despite being appointed on April 14, 2023 (retroactive to January 1, 2023), *see Exhibit 12*, Commissioner McWilliams has not filed a financial disclosure statement with the Secretary of State since the appointment. She previously filed a financial disclosure statement on January 27, 2021, but that was for a prior appointment.
- i) Gerasimos "Gerry" Razatos: Despite being appointed on May 1, 2023, see Exhibit 13, Commissioner Razatos did not file a financial disclosure statement with the Secretary of State until March 12, 2024. See Exhibit 14.
- j) Edward Vigil. It is unknown when Commissioner Vigil was appointed, but he has never filed a financial disclosure statement with the Secretary of State.
- k) Katie Zemlick. It is unknown when Commissioner Zemlick was appointed, but she has never filed a financial disclosure statement with the Secretary of State.
- 6. Movants greatly desire that this hearing proceed as scheduled. This is a critically important issue for the wellbeing of New Mexicans and their land. However, this is a jurisdictional matter, and if ignored, would create a serious issue on appeal for any party dissatisfied with the outcome of the rulemaking. If a decisionmaker presides over a case without authority to do so, jurisdictional error is committed, which can be raised at any time, even after judgment and on appeal. *In re Estate of Kemnitz*, 1981-NMCA-013, ¶ 7, 95 N.M. 513. Here, the nine WQCC members who, on January 9, 2024, voted on whether to hold a hearing in this matter had not filed disclosure forms after their appointments and prior to the vote, and therefore, the proceedings in this matter are without legal authority and void as a matter of law. Accordingly,

Movants respectfully request that the hearing in this matter be cancelled or postponed until each

member files the appropriate disclosure statement with the Secretary of State and a new vote is

held authorizing the proceedings. The Commissioners must comply with the law and file the

required financial disclosures with the Secretary of State prior to performing any official duties,

including the appointment of a hearing officer and initiation of rulemaking proceedings.

Movants are concerned that to do otherwise would create a serious issue on appeal which would

delay this important rulemaking, possibly for years. A prohibition against treated or untreated

produced water discharge, disposal and reuse for any entity, including via any federal permit, is a

matter of great importance and urgency, for the protection of public health and welfare and our

environment.

7. In order to cure this jurisdictional infirmity and to avoid delay, Movants

respectfully request that the Commission cancel the hearing, dismiss this case, and file the

required financial disclosures and that NMED in consultation with stakeholders reissue a

rulemaking petition post haste.

8. Movants reached out to other parties to obtain their position on this Motion before

filing and can report as follows: Select Water Solutions takes no position on the disqualification

issue, but it does not oppose the requested cancellation of the hearing. NMOGA takes no

position on the disqualification issue but supports the request to cancel the hearing. NMED

opposes the Motion. No other party provided their position before the filing of this Motion.


