

## Block 30

The following describes the necessary details required by NMED for an Individual Water Quality Certification.

1. See blocks 8, 9, 10, and 12 in the PCN.
2. Please see attached supporting document for block 19 for the PCN describing the project and its need.
3. The project is seeking coverage for CWA Section 404 authorization under USACE NWP 13.
4. Discharges from the project area would only be due to stormwater flows in the arroyo. The chance for significant flow in the arroyo is minimized after monsoon season ends in September. Flows in the Tijeras Arroyo that make it to the AMAFCA owned Tijeras Sediment Retention Structure and Tijeras Channel would discharge to the Rio Grande.
5. The Water Authority will ensure the work area is protected from interacting with stormwater flows until the project is complete. This may entail setting up a temporary diversion around the work area using concrete barriers or similar means of temporary flow diversion.
6. Please see the attached Kirtland Airforce Base 813 approval for the project.
7. A pre-filing meeting request was submitted to NMED SWQB on June 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2022.
8. The project proponent hereby certifies that all information contained herein is true, accurate, and complete to the best of my knowledge and belief.
9. The project proponent hereby requests that the certifying authority review and take action on this CWA Section 401 certification request within the applicable reasonable period of time.
