Air Quality Operating Permit  
for 29-6 No4 CDP Compressor Station of Harvest Four Corners LLC

Harvest Four Corners LLC at 1755 Arroyo Dr; Bloomfield, NM 87413 has submitted an air quality operating permit application to the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) for an air quality operating permit for its 29-6 No4 CDP Compressor Station. The owner of this plant is Harvest Four Corners LLC. The exact location of the facility is at latitude and longitude decimal degrees: 36.704444, -107.496944 Datum: NAD83. To aid in locating this facility, the approximate location is 13 miles ESE of Navajo Dam in Rio Arriba County, NM. This application file has been assigned an Operating Permit Number P028-R5 and TEMPO Agency Interest ID No. 1013.

Previously, the facility received an air quality construction permit and is in operation. The main purpose of the facility is the compression and dehydration of natural gas.

This operating permit application is for a permit renewal. Per 20.2.70.401.C.(4) NMAC, this permitting action involves renewal of the Title V Operating Permit, and inclusions of new regulatory requirements of 20.2.50 NMAC, and New Source Review of permitting Administrative Revisions 1073M7R3 through 1073M7R7 to included several Like-Kind Engine replacements.

There are no changes to the existing air emission limits in this permitting action. The NMED has conducted a preliminary review of the information submitted with the permit application. This review included evaluation of the emission rates and applicable requirements to determine compliance.

The NMED has made a preliminary determination that this facility will comply with the requirements of Title 20, New Mexico Administrative Code (NMAC), Chapter 2, Parts 7, 50, 61, 70, 71, 72, 73, and 82; 40 CFR 50; 40 CFR 63 Subparts HH and ZZZZ; and the New Mexico Air Quality Control Act. Therefore, the preliminary intent of NMED is to issue the air quality operating permit on or before April 13, 2023.

Written requests for public hearing must state the nature of the issues proposed to be raised in the hearing. Comments must be based on the requirements of the applicable state and federal air quality regulations and the Clean Air Act. Comments or hearing requests must be received within 30 days after the public notice is published.

Due to the public health emergency order, certain NMED offices are closed to the public.
