Air Quality Operating Permit  
for Cowboy CDP of XTO Energy Inc

XTO Energy Inc at 22777 Springwoods Village Parkway; Spring, TX 77389 has submitted an air quality operating permit application to the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) for an air quality operating permit for its Cowboy CDP. The owner of this plant is XTO Energy Inc. The exact location of the facility is at latitude and longitude decimal degrees: 32.159932, -103.841589 Datum: NAD83. To aid in locating this facility, the approximate location is 14 mi SE of Malaga in Eddy County, NM. This application file has been assigned an Operating Permit Number P297 and TEMPO Agency Interest ID No. 38481.

Previously, the facility received an air quality construction permit and is in operation.

The main purpose of the facility is to process natural gas and provide a central delivery point for crude oil.

This operating permit application is for a new permit. Per 20.2.70.401.C.(4) NMAC, this permitting action involves incorporation of changes made in the issued NSR permit 7877-M1. The NSR permit 7877-M1 removed two heaters, added selective catalytic reduction to two heaters and cry heaters, reduced tank capacity, added truck loading emission, increase and updated SSM activities, updated fugitives count and calculations, updated tank throughput, added four emergency generators, added malfunction emission, increased flare purge gas flow rate, added electric compressors.

The emissions, as established in NSR Permit 7877-M1 and brought forward into this permit are as follows. This is a new Title V operating permit and does not have a previous Title V operating permit to compare emission changes. Emissions are expressed in tons per year (tpy). Nitrogen Oxides (NO<sub>x</sub>) at 177 tpy; Carbon Monoxide (CO) at 145 tpy; Volatile Organic Compounds (VOC) at 215 tpy; Sulfur Dioxide (SO<sub>2</sub>) at 29 tpy; Particulate Matter 10 microns or less (PM<sub>10</sub>) at 38 tpy, and Particulate Matter 2.5 microns or less (PM<sub>2.5</sub>) at 38 tpy; and greenhouse gas (CO<sub>2</sub>e) 964,588 tpy.

There are no changes to the existing air emission limits in this permitting action.

The NMED has conducted a preliminary review of the information submitted with the permit application. This review included evaluation of the emission rates and applicable requirements to determine compliance.

The NMED has made a preliminary determination that this facility will comply with the requirements of Title 20, New Mexico Administrative Code (NMAC), Chapter 2, Parts 7, 50, 61, 70, 71, 72, 73, 77 and 82; 40 CFR 50; 40 CFR 60 Subparts [A, Dc, Kb, JJJ and OOOOa]; 40 CFR 63 Subparts [A and ZZZZ]; and the New Mexico Air Quality Control Act. Therefore, the preliminary intent of NMED is to issue the air quality operating permit on or before May 19, 2023.

Written requests for public hearing must state the nature of the issues proposed to be raised in the hearing. Comments must be based on the requirements of the applicable state and federal air quality regulations and

the Clean Air Act. Comments or hearing requests must be received within 30 days after the public notice is published.

Due to the public health emergency order, certain NMED offices maybe closed to the public.
