Air Quality Operating Permit
for 29-6 No2 Central Delivery Point of Harvest Four Corners LLC

Harvest Four Corners LLC at 1755 Arroyo Drive; Bloomfield, NM 87413 has submitted an air quality operating permit application to the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) for an air quality operating permit for its 29-6 No2 Central Delivery Point. The owner of this plant is Harvest Four Corners, LLC. The exact location of the facility is at latitude and longitude decimal degrees: 36.745272, -107.445581 Datum: WGS84. To aid in locating this facility, the approximate location is about 18 miles E of Blanco in Rio Arriba County, NM. This application file has been assigned an Operating Permit Number P038R5 and TEMPO Agency Interest ID No. 1007.

Previously, the facility received an air quality construction permit and is in operation.

The main purpose of the facility is to compress and dehydrate pipeline quality natural gas for pipeline transmission.

This operating permit application is for a permit renewal. Per 20.2.70.401.C.(4) NMAC, this permitting action involves renewing and modifying the Title V operating permit by adding two additional dehydrators that are in the current construction permit.

The emissions, as established in NSR Permit 1035-M11 and brought forward into this permit are as follows. Parentheses note changes in emissions from previous operating permit – P038-R4. Emissions are expressed in tons per year (tpy). Nitrogen Oxides (NO_x) at 159.3 tpy (+0.2); Carbon Monoxide (CO) at 183.1 tpy (+0.2); Volatile Organic Compounds (VOC) at 196.2 tpy (+1.2); Sulfur Dioxide (SO₂) at 0.2 tpy (no change); Particulate Matter 10 microns or less (PM₁₀) at 3.7 tpy (+0.1), and Particulate Matter 2.5 microns or less (PM_{2.5}) at 3.7 tpy (+0.1); and greenhouse gas (CO_{2e}) 84,618 tpy.

The NMED has conducted a preliminary review of the information submitted with the permit application. This review included evaluation of the emission rates and applicable requirements to determine compliance.

The NMED has made a preliminary determination that this facility will comply with the requirements of Title 20, New Mexico Administrative Code (NMAC), Chapter 2, Parts 7, 61, 70, 71, 72, 73, 77 and 82; 40 CFR 60 Subparts A, JJJJ, OOOOa; 40 CFR 63 Subparts A, HH, and ZZZZ; and the New Mexico Air Quality Control Act. Therefore, the preliminary intent of NMED is to issue the air quality operating permit on or before January 27, 2024.

Written requests for public hearing must state the nature of the issues proposed to be raised in the hearing. Comments must be based on the requirements of the applicable state and federal air quality regulations and the Clean Air Act. Comments or hearing requests must be received within 30 days after the public notice is published.
