Air Quality Operating Permit  
for Roswell Compressor Station No9 of Transwestern Pipeline Company, LLC

Transwestern Pipeline Company, LLC at 8501 Jefferson St NE; Albuquerque, NM 87113 has submitted an air quality operating permit application to the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) for an air quality operating permit for its Roswell Compressor Station No9. The owner of this plant is Transwestern Pipeline Company, LLC. The exact location of the facility is at latitude and longitude decimal degrees: 33.51, -104.516944 Datum: NAD83. To aid in locating this facility, the approximate location is 5 mi N of Roswell in Chaves County, NM. This application file has been assigned an Operating Permit Number P154-R5 and TEMPO Agency Interest ID No. 10.

Previously, the facility received an air quality construction permit and is in operation.

The main purpose of the facility is to compress natural gas and discharge them into the pipelines.

This operating permit application is for a permit renewal. Per 20.2.70.401.C.(4) NMAC, this permitting action does not involve any physical change to the facility.

There are no changes to the existing air emission limits in this permitting action.

The NMED has conducted a preliminary review of the information submitted with the permit application. This review included evaluation of the emission rates and applicable requirements to determine compliance.

The NMED has made a preliminary determination that this facility will comply with the requirements of Title 20, New Mexico Administrative Code (NMAC), Chapter 2, Parts 50, 61, 70, 71, 72, 73, and 74; 40 CFR 63 Subparts [A and ZZZZ]; and the New Mexico Air Quality Control Act. Therefore, the preliminary intent of NMED is to issue the air quality operating permit on or before May 17, 2024.

Interested persons may obtain the draft operating permit, submit written comments, or request a public hearing on Operating Permit Number P154-R5 by contacting Urshula Bajracharya at the New Mexico Environment Department, Air Quality Bureau, 525 Camino de los Marquez Suite 1, Santa Fe, NM 87505-1816, or by email at [Urshula.Bajracharya@env.nm.gov](mailto:Urshula.Bajracharya@env.nm.gov). Written requests for public hearing must state the nature of the issues proposed to be raised in the hearing. Comments must be based on the requirements of the applicable state and federal air quality regulations and the Clean Air Act. Comments or hearing requests must be received within 30 days after the public notice is published.
