Air Quality Operating Permit for San Juan County, New Mexico

San Juan County at 100 South Oliver Drive, Aztec, NM 87410 has submitted an air quality operating permit application to the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) for an air quality operating permit for its San Juan County Regional Landfill. The owner of this landfill is San Juan County. The exact location of the facility is at latitude and longitude decimal degrees: 36.767189, -108.049203 Datum: NAD83. To aid in locating this facility, the approximate location is 5 miles southwest of Aztec in San Juan County, NM. This application file has been assigned an Operating Permit Number P246LR3 and TEMPO Agency Interest ID No. 4544.

Previously, the facility received an air quality construction permit and is in operation. The main purpose of the facility is to function as a municipal solid waste landfill that receives construction and demolition debris, ash, industrial solid waste, packing house and killing plant offal, petroleum contaminated soil (PCS), sludge, special waste not otherwise specified, spill of a chemical substance or commercial product, and treated formerly characteristic hazardous waste.

This permit application is for a TV permit renewal. Per 20.2.70.401.C.(4) NMAC, this permitting action involves renewal as well as incorporating a previously issued construction permit No. 9846 to update calculations and add the Non-Enclosed Flare, Unit 5.

The estimated maximum air pollutant emissions to the atmosphere from this facility after the requested operating permit is issued are as follows. Parentheses note changes in emissions from previous operating permit – P246LR2. Emissions are expressed in tons per year (tpy). Nitrogen Oxides (NOx) at 6.3 tpy (not reported); Carbon Monoxide (CO) at 28.5 tpy (not reported); Volatile Organic Compounds (VOC) at 4.1 tpy (-23.7); Sulfur Dioxide (SO₂) at 7.5 tpy (not reported); Particulate Matter 10 microns or less (PM₁₀) at 24.1 tpy (+1.2), and Particulate Matter 2.5 microns or less (PM_{2.5}) at 3.8 tpy (+1.5); and greenhouse gas (CO₂e) <75,000 tpy.

The NMED has conducted a preliminary review of the information submitted with the permit application. This review included evaluation of the emission rates and applicable requirements to determine compliance.

The NMED has made a preliminary determination that this facility will comply with the requirements of Title 20, New Mexico Administrative Code (NMAC), Chapter 2, Parts 1, 7, 61, 64, 70, 71, 72, 73, and 77; 40 CFR 60 Subparts A and XXX; and the New Mexico Air Quality Control Act. Therefore, the preliminary intent of NMED is to issue the air quality operating permit on or before March 28, 2025.

Written requests for public hearing must state the nature of the issues proposed to be raised in the hearing. Comments must be based on the requirements of the applicable state and federal air quality regulations and

the Clean Air Act. Comments or hearing requests must be received within 30 days after the public notice is published.
