Denial of Air Quality Permit Application No. RE05 8661R1 (Agency Interest No. 39077 - PRN20240003) - PG - Rio Re: Rancho Facility

Dear Payam Ghoreishi:

This letter is in response to your air quality permit application dated December 23, 2024 to substitute equipment at the PG - Rio Rancho Facility located in Mora, New Mexico. The Department received the application on December 26, 2024.

The Department has completed a review of the application for the proposed equipment substitution and has determined that the permit revision cannot be issued. Unpermitted equipment has already been placed on the property, which violates the conditions of the existing permit. The existing permit and the requested substitution equipment lists do not include a Mobiscreen or AB Volvo Penta 201633943, TWD1673GE, 685HP engine.

Therefore, in accordance with 20.2.72 NMAC, Section 208.A the application for a permit revision is denied.

Appeal Procedures

20.2.72 NMAC, Section 207, provides that any person who participated in a permitting action before the Department and who is adversely affected by such permitting action, may file a petition for hearing before the Environmental Improvement Board. The petition shall be made in writing to the Environmental Improvement Board within thirty (30) days from the date notice is given of the Department's action and shall specify the portions of the permitting action to which the petitioner objects, certify that a copy of the petition has been mailed or hand-delivered and attach a copy of the permitting action for which review is sought. Unless a timely request for hearing is made, the decision of the Department shall be final. The petition shall be copied simultaneously to the Department upon receipt of the appeal notice. If the petitioner is not the applicant or permittee, the petitioner shall mail or hand-deliver a copy of the petition to the applicant or permittee. The Department shall certify the administrative record to the board. Petitions for a hearing shall be sent to:
