

Public Notice

The New Mexico Environment Department, Environmental Protection Division, Radiation Control Bureau is announcing that it is scheduling a meeting of the Radiation Technical Advisory Council on September 20, 2023, to discuss the amendments to the Radiation Protection Rules, 20.3 NMAC.

The proposed revisions include the following four parts:

20.3.4 NMAC "STANDARDS FOR PROTECTION AGAINST RADIATION";

20.3.5 NMAC "RADIATION SAFETY REQUIREMENTS FOR INDUSTRIAL RADIOGRAPHERS";

20.3.12 NMAC "LICENSES AND RADIATION SAFETY REQUIREMENTS FOR WELL LOGGING"; and

20.3.15 NMAC "LICENSES AND RADIATION SAFETY REQUIREMENTS FOR IRRADIATORS;

New Mexico must maintain a Radiation Protection Program compatible with the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC). This includes revising the New Mexico rules to conform to changes in the federal regulations.
