Approval of this form waives the 180-day limit and adds an additional 180 days in which the evaluation or inspection can be used as a valid property transfer document. This is accepted by the department when the system is not in use at any point after the inspection or evaluation but prior to transfer of property. Expiration dates are always expressed as the last day of the anniversary month which the evaluation or inspection were performed. This waiver is based department policy.
