<b>Angle Fire, Village of</b>	Community Recycling Expansion	Purchase a multi-material, large capacity, horizontal baler for their transfer station. This will increase their capacity to process materials, and offer their services to surrounding communities.	\$71,425
<b>Lincoln County Solid Waste Authority</b>	Expand Recycling in the Ruidoso Retail Business Community	Purchases 1,725 plastic recycling containers for 575 businesses. Each business will receive (3) indoor recycling containers and an informative recycling brochure.	\$8,625
<b>McKinley County</b>	McKinley County Recycling Expansion Project	To advance their recycling activities through the creation of a recycling plan, marketing campaign, and setting out recycling bins.	\$20,000
<b>Mora County</b>	Motor-Oil and Cardboard Recycling in Mora County	Purchase (4) motor-oil collection tanks and (3) cardboard collection bins at transfer stations. The motor-oil will be used to heat a convenience center.	\$15,858
<b>Santa Ana, Pueblo of</b>	Santa Ana Resource Recovery and Recycling Park	Use funds to develop a resource Recovery and Recycling Park at their solid waste transfer station to include (1) 6-bin recycling trailer, a storage shed for the collection of household hazardous waste, community outreach and education efforts.	\$20,000
<b>Taos County</b>	Taos County Solid Waste Recycling and Illegal Dump Site Program	Purchase (2) alley cat recycling trailers for plastic collection. Use remaining funds to purchase recycling bins for plastic collection.	\$20,000
<b>Tucumcari, City of</b>	2008 Recycling Containers	Funds will purchase (2) event recycling stations, (20) office recycling stations, and will help to purchase (1) alley cat collection trailer.	\$10,000

<b>Guadalupe County</b>	Anton Chico Area Illegal Dumpsites	Clean-up (4) historic illegal dumpsites, install signage to discourage illegal dumping, and conduct public education forums to educate the public against illegal dumping and its consequences.	\$27,100
<b>Mora County</b>	Holman Illegal Dumpsite Cleanup	Clean-up the Holman illegal dumpsite, abate future illegal dumping by installing signs and conducting public education regarding illegal dumping.	\$19,945
<b>Santa Ana, Pueblo of</b>	Santa Ana Illegal Dump Clean-up	Clean-up a historic dump site, conduct community education and outreach on proper solid waste disposal and the hazards of illegal dumping, and reclaim the dumpsite for a Resource Recovery and Recycling Park.	\$20,000
<b>Valencia County</b>	Sand Hill Restoration	Clean-up a illegal dumpsite, install signs, bollards and cable to discourage future illegal dumping and conduct community outreach to educate about illegal dumping.	\$8,106
