

- It is a proven effective method, as paunch manure and other parts not accepted in rendering will compost;
- Timeliness – allows producers to manage butcher waste promptly...no waiting for rendering truck to arrive or to haul to an off-site plant or landfill;
- Easy and works for all butcher waste and sizes and species of animals– including diseased birds and whole dead animals;
- Pathogen kill occurs during composting process; and
- Can be done year-round with equipment and materials on hand.
