2015 Appropriation



The 2015 New Mexico Legislature Special Session appropriated \$1 million to the New Mexico Environment Department "for the restoration of rivers and streams statewide, including clearing vegetation, lowering river bank lines, replanting native species vegetation and installing erosion control measures." The appropriation will be used to fund projects for the River Stewardship Program and to match federal Clean Water Act funds. NMED will issue a Request for Proposals in fall 2015 in order to select projects for funding. All project work must be completed prior to the reversion date for the funds: June 30, 2019.
