**ABCWUA Aquifer Storage and Recovery**

Abstract

The Albuquerque Bernalillo County Water Utility Authority (ABCWUA) is implementing aquifer storage and recovery (ASR) projects for conjunctive management of surface and groundwater water resources using treated San Juan-Chama water diverted from the Rio Grande. The purpose is to recharge the Santa Fe Group aquifer system of the Middle Rio Grande Basin and to recover the water for later use. This talk will provide an overview of the ABCWUA's ASR projects and future plans, highlighting the recent ASR well retrofit and water quality test that was conducted using Webster Well 1.
