

The following amendments are being made to RFP #: 80-667-30-0001.

Amendment #1: Please replace Section V.B of the RFP with the following:

B. EMERGENCY RESPONSE SCENARIO

Describe in detail what steps your firm would take in investigating, determining the source of, and addressing this scenario: During road repairs in a rural part of New Mexico, construction workers notice the odor of gasoline in their construction trench. Simultaneously, residents of a nearby mobile home park start to complain that their drinking water tastes “funny”. A nearby intersection contains the following businesses: one corner has a gasoline station and convenience store. Another corner is occupied by a dry cleaner. Yet another corner contains a truck stop. The fourth corner contains a quick oil change business. Except for telephone and electrical service, the area is not hooked up to any municipal utilities. Telecommunication lines are located underground. Overhead electrical lines transect the area.

Do not present the potential cost that you would charge for the completion of the investigation and/or remedial action work in the above-requested emergency response scenario. The Department is reviewing only your technical approach to this problem.

Amendment #2: Please replace Section V.F of the RFP with the following:

F. CAMPAIGN CONTRIBUTION DISCLOSURE FORM AND ANTI-COLLUSION STATEMENT

A proposal will be deemed non-responsive and will be dropped from further evaluation if it does not include a completed “Disclosure of Campaign Contributions” form (please see Appendix D for more information). Please submit your completed Appendix D with your proposal in a separate, sealed envelope. Only one copy of Appendix D needs to be submitted. In addition, a notarized anti-collusion affidavit, required in accordance with 20.5.17.301.C.2 NMAC, is necessary in order for a proposal to be considered responsive.
