Questions/Answers

Q1: Under Technical Specifications, does the 10 page limit exclude a resume?

A1: Yes the 10 page proposal excludes a resume/ Statement of Qualifications.

Q2: In the proposal do you want quarterly monitoring?

A2: Appendix D, Cost Table mentions 4 quarters of monitoring.

Q3: Is this site's contamination currently threatening or has it already impacted a water supply?

A3: To the best of the Bureau's knowledge no water supply has been impacted. Additional information is available in the reports.

Q4: Has the air sparging been effective?

A: Air sparging has addressed the vapor issues, but not the groundwater contamination.

Q: Can a copy of the pre proposal sign- up sheet be disclosed as a public document?

A: After award, any written determinations made pursuant to these rules, the evaluation committee report and each proposal, except those portions for which the offeror has made a written request for confidentiality, shall be open to public inspection. PSTB considers all documentation that is created post-RFP issuance, including sign-in sheets, to be subject to this requirement.
