**RE: FINAL DETERMINATION, CLASS 2 PERMIT MODIFICATION DECISION
WASTE ISOLATION PILOT PLANT

Dear Messrs. Shrader and Breidenbach:

On September 19, 2016, the New Mexico Environment Department (“NMED”) took final administrative action on a Class 2 modification request (“Modification”) to the Waste Isolation Pilot Plant Hazardous Waste Facility Permit (“Permit”). The Department of Energy Carlsbad Field Office and Nuclear Waste Partnership LLC submitted this Modification on June 3, 2016, and was received by NMED on July 8, 2016. The Modification is entitled “*Revise the RCRA Contingency Plan and Associated Emergency Response Personnel Training, and Active Room Ventilation Rate*” and was submitted as a 2-Item Class 2 Modification.

The Modification was evaluated and processed in accordance with the requirements specified in 20.4.1.900 NMAC (incorporating 40 CFR §270.42(b)) and was subject to a 60-day public comment period running from June 8, 2016 through August 8, 2016. NMED received written comments from several individuals and organizations during the comment period.

NMED hereby approves this Modification with changes. Attached is a CD containing the revised applicable sections of the Permit where language deleted from the permit is **stricken out**, language added to the permit as proposed in the Modification is highlighted in **redline** and

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specific language changes imposed by NMED are distinguished by yellow highlight. A clean final version of the applicable Permit sections is also included on the disc. This permit modification is effective on October 19, 2016.
