## Restaurant, meat market at El Mezquite Market in Los Lunas upgraded after food safety violations corrected

LOS LUNAS — The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) upgraded El Mesquite Market, 2360 Main St. NE in Los Lunas, to "Approved" status after it was re-inspected by NMED on Feb. 24.

All violations of the New Mexico Food Service and Food Processing Regulations found during the inspection that resulted in a downgrade earlier this month have been corrected.
