U.S. EPA Region 6 Initiates Fifth Five-Year Review of Site Remedy September 2021



The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency Region 6 (EPA) and the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) are initiating the fifth five-year review of the remedy for the Cleveland Mill Superfund Site located in Grant County, New Mexico, approximately 5.5 miles northeast of Silver City.

The Site was added to the National Priorities List in March 1989 due to the presence of mill tailings that had contaminated soil near the mine site and sediment in the streambed of Little Walnut Creek with metals, including arsenic, beryllium, cadmium, lead, and zinc. The metals had the potential to contaminate nearby surface water and groundwater.

Between 1997 and 1998, the Site underwent a removal action that included excavation of the contaminated tailings and sediment, treatment of the excavated material, disposal of the treated material into an on-Site disposal cell, and construction of erosion control measures to maintain the integrity of the disposal cell. While the Site was deleted from the National Priorities list in July 2001, it continues to be monitored and maintained annually.

A five-year review is conducted after cleanup is complete at a Superfund site. Its purpose is to evaluate the performance of the site remedy and to determine if it remains protective of human health and the environment.

EPA seeks the public's input for this five-year review. Please contact EPA or NMED to schedule an interview. Interviews will be held in October 2021.
