The New Mexico Radioactive Waste Consultation Task Force (Task Force) is a consortium of state legislators serving on the Radioactive and Hazardous Materials Interim Committee and executive administrators for the Cabinet-level agencies that regulate activities associated with radioactive and mixed wastes being transported, produced, stored, and/or disposed of within the borders of our state. Transparency regarding these activities is an important goal of the Task Force, and as such, in response to public input we request that the National Nuclear Security Administration (NNSA) better engage with the Task Force on current and future plans with respect to the disposal of such wastes. The Task Force also finds it imperative that the NNSA engage in public meetings with the citizens of New Mexico regarding its plans.

Specifically, New Mexico and its citizens expect to be the first state engaged by NNSA in any discussion of waste streams coming to the Waste Isolation Pilot Plant (WIPP). Therefore, the Task Force requests that NNSA leadership make themselves available for regular status updates on WIPP, including but not limited to, the surplus plutonium program and transportation plans for surplus plutonium shipments between DOE facilities that will enter New Mexico for treatment or disposal.
