# SJGS Existing Closure Plan Under DP-1327

- ❑ DP-1327 Closure Plan currently in place.
- ❑ NMED and PNM actively meeting to discuss components of plan.
- ❑ Current financial assurance = \$45,960,000 (Liberty Mutual).
- ❑ PNM has requested to amend the Closure Plan and their request is currently under review.
- ❑ Any response to PNM will include contingency language that references the ongoing progress of the HB142 work.



# HB142 Study/Plan Development Progress

- ❑ Two dedicated positions being created to oversee the project.
  - ❑ One position in the Pollution Prevention Section
  - ❑ One position in the Remediation Oversight Section
- ❑ Developing scope of work for study of Remediation and Restoration Options.
- ❑ Funding for contractors and staff is in place
  - ❑ \$560K in funding for contracts (300s)
  - ❑ \$300K in funding for staff salaries (200s)
