Assistance for Public Water Systems at Risk of Shortage

Santa Fe, NM – The N.M. Environment Department, the N.M. Office of the State Engineer, the N.M. Rural Water Association, the N.M. Association of Counties, the N.M. Municipal League, and the Rural Community Assistance Corporation are collaborating to provide public water systems in New Mexico with recommendations, training and expert consultation on how to safeguard the sustainability of their drinking water sources.
