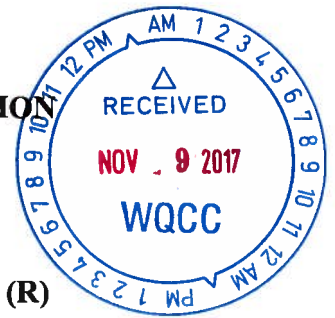

The New Mexico Municipal League Environmental Quality Association (NMML) hereby provides notice of the substitution of one of its previously-declared technical testimony witnesses. In furtherance of this Notice, NMML states as follows:

1. Due to a number of scheduling conflicts, Mr. Stomp is unable to attend the hearing scheduled by the Second Procedural Order which sets forth a date range for the hearing from November 14, 2017 to November 17, 2017.
2. The person who will substitute as NMML's witness in place of Mr. Stomp is Mark Kelly whose resume is attached hereto.
3. Mr. Kelly is the Compliance Division Manager for the Albuquerque Bernalillo County Water Utility Authority. His job responsibilities include ensuring that the Water Authority complies with the requirements of the Safe Drinking Water Act, the Clean Water Act and various groundwater discharge permits. His Division collects samples for these groundwater discharge permits and is responsible for all permit applications and renewals.
4. Mr. Kelly is familiar with the written pre-filed testimony of Mr. Stomp; and indeed, he assisted Mr. Stomp in the preparation of said testimony. Mr. Kelly adopts the written technical testimony of Mr. Stomp and he does not intend to change that testimony in any way.
