**POST SCHEDULING ORDER
EXCEPTIONS TO THE HEARING OFFICER REPORT**

The WQCC designated Erin Anderson to serve as hearing officer for WQCC 17-03 (R) on May 5, 2017. The hearing officer report was filed on April 6, 2017.

1. Exceptions are due within 30 days, word versions in redline format should be emailed to the hearing officer, preferably within two weeks, so a draft revised report can be circulated among the parties. A full thirty days will fall on May 7, 2018. But ideally on or before April 27, 2018.
2. The hearing officer is compiling the proposed rule language from all the parties and will post them as an exhibit to the report online. For those parties who have not yet formatted their exhibits, please have the rule number, party proposing, and proposed rule language. The deadline to submit the proposed rule language is April 11, 2018. An email was circulated last week requesting each parties rule(s).
3. Any pleadings should be filed with the Board administrator. An original plus twelve copies are required.
