NEW MEXICO WATER QUALITY CONTROL COMMISSION NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING TO CONSIDER APPEAL OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLIANCE ORDER ISSUED TO LA VISTA DEL CANYON MOBILE HOME PARK IN OTERO COUNTY, NM, WQCC 17-09 (A) The New Mexico Water Quality Control Commission (WQCC) will hold a public hearing on January 9, 2018 in Mabry Hall of the Jerry Apodaca Education Building, located at 300 Don Gaspar, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87501 to consider an appeal filed by Champ Investments, LLC dba La Vista Mobile Home Park ("Petitioner") to Administrative Compliance Order No. GWQB 17-21 ("ACO") issued by the Ground Water Quality Bureau ("GWQB") to La Vista Del Canyon Mobile Home Park located at 711 S. Canyon Road, Alamogordo, New Mexico, 88310 (the "Property"). The Property is a mobile home facility containing approximately twenty-five (25) mobile home spaces and/or connections used for residential purposes. The ACO imposes upon Petitioner civil penalties for four (4) violations: 1) discharging without a permit in violation of 20.6.2.3.3104 NMAC; 2) failure to obtain a discharge permit in violation of 20.6.2.3106 and 20.6.2.3114 NMAC; 3) failure to report and notify the GWQB of discharges in violation of 20.6.2.1203.A(1) & (2) NMAC; and 4) failure to take corrective action in violation of 20.6.2.1203.A(5) NMAC. The public hearing will begin immediately following the Commission's regular business meeting, which starts at 9 AM. The hearing will be conducted in accordance with the Water Quality Act, NMSA 1978 Å§ 74-6-10, the Water Quality Control Commission Adjudicatory Procedures found in 20.1.3 NMAC, and all other applicable law.
