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**NEW MEXICO WATER QUALITY CONTROL COMMISSION
NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING TO CONSIDER THE ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLIANCE ORDER ISSUED TO
MARISALA ORNELAS, VISION MOBILE HOME PARK, DISCHARGE PERMIT DP-1691, SAN JUAN
COUNTY, NM, WQCC 21-04 (CO)**

The New Mexico Water Quality Control Commission (WQCC) will hold a virtual public hearing Tuesday, June 8, 2021, continuing subsequent days if necessary, via the WebEx video conferencing platform to consider the Administrative Compliance Order No. WQCC 21-04 (CO) (“ACO”) issued by the Ground Water Quality Bureau (“GWQB”) to Ms. Marisela Ornelas dba Vision Mobile Home Park LLC (“petitioner”). Vision Mobile Home Park is located at 1 Road 6367, Kirtland, NM 87417 (“Facility”). The Facility is a mobile home park discharging approximately 8,700 gallons per day of domestic wastewater. The ACO imposes upon the petitioner civil penalties for violations of 20.6.3104 NMAC, Failure to Discharge in a Manner Consistent with the Terms and Conditions of a Discharge Permit and 20.6.2.3107.A NMAC, Failure to Submit Monitoring Reports Required by the Discharge Permit.

The WQCC will begin its regular monthly meeting at 9:00 a.m., and the hearing will begin at the conclusion of the WQCC’s regular business and the subsequent Ironhorse Permian Basin, LLC variance petition hearing.
