Dear Mr. Moudy:

The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) received the Notification of Class 1 Modification to Hazardous Waste Storage Facility Operating Permit, Advanced Chemical Treatment, Inc., with cover letter dated October 26, 2016, on October 31, 2016. In the submittal, the Permittee provides an updated map of the permitted Facility boundaries and an updated Emergency Coordinator and Alternate List for the Hazardous Waste Storage Facility Operating Permit (Permit) Contingency Plan.

The revised map was provided in response to a previous Class 1 permit modification request, dated August 26, 2016. After reviewing the submitted map depicting the new permitted storage facility boundaries, the NMED has determined that the map submitted is adequate.

After reviewing the submitted Emergency Coordinator and Alternate List for the Permit's Contingency Plan, the NMED has determined that the list is adequate.

Since the modification is a self-implementing change that does not require approval from NMED, and the Permittee has already sent out a notice of the modification request to all persons on the facility mailing list, the Permittee must incorporate the proposed changes into the current (effective March 13, 2002) operating permit upon receipt of this letter.

Further, the New Mexico Hazardous Waste Management Fee Regulations 20.4.2 NMAC require assessment of fees when administrative review of a document is complete. NMED has attached an invoice to this letter. Payment of the fees is due within sixty (60) calendar days from the date that you receive the invoice in accordance with 20.4.2.301.C NMAC. If you disagree with the fee assessed, you may notify the NMED in writing, at the address above, of the intent to appeal the invoice under the provisions of 20.4.2.302.A NMAC.

If payment is by check, then you must provide the invoice number on the check. If payment is transmitted electronically, then you must submit a letter to Mr. James Valdez, NMED Hazardous Waste Bureau, indicating the invoice number, payment amount, and the assessed activity prior to transferring funds.


