The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) received Kirtland Air Force Base's February 17, 2010 request for a Class 3 permit modification to the above referenced permits. The NMED has made a determination that the submittals are administratively complete. The New Mexico Hazardous Waste Permit and Corrective Action Fee Regulations, 20.4.2.201.B(2) NMAC require the assessment of fees after an application is deemed administratively complete. The fee invoice is attached to this letter. Upon receipt of the payment, the NMED will initiate a technical review of the submittals in accordance with 20.4.2.201.B(3) NMAC.

Payment is due within sixty (60) calendar days from the date that you receive the invoice in accordance with 20.4.2.301.C NMAC. If you disagree with the fee assessed, you may notify the NMED in writing, at the address above, of the intent to appeal the invoice under the provisions of 20.4.2.302.A NMAC.


