The New Mexico Environment Department (Department) has received the Class 3 Permit Modification Request for the Addition of Open Detonation (OD) Units at Technical Area (TA)-36-8 and TA-39-6 (PMR), dated July 19, 2011, from the United States Department of Energy and Los Alamos National Security, LLC, collectively the Permittees. The Permittees seek to modify the Hazardous Waste Facility Permit (Permit) for Los Alamos National Laboratory (LANL) to include within the Permit hazardous waste open detonation treatment units at TA 36-8 and TA39-6. The Permittees submitted additional supplemental information on August 18, 2011. The Department has reviewed the PMR and hereby deems it administratively complete.

The New Mexico Hazardous Waste Permit and Corrective Action Fee regulations, Section 20.4.2.201.F, require the assessment of a fee to modify a permit at the time of an administrative completeness determination. A fee invoice is attached indicating that the fee is paid and credited against the FY2011 fee agreement. If you disagree with the fee assessed you may notify the Department in writing at the address above of your intent to appeal the invoice under the
