The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) issued a public notice on January12, 2015, concerning the intent to grant Corrective Action Complete (CAC) with Controls status for the Sandia National Laboratories Mixed Waste Landfill (MWL) and announcing a 60-day comment period that ended March 13, 2015. NMED is extending the public comment period through **5:00 p.m. MDT on April 13, 2015**, to receive additional comment on this action.

PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

NMED announces the extension of the comment period for the CAC proposal, which will now end at **5:00 p.m. MDT**, April 13, 2015. Any person who wishes to comment on this action or request a public hearing should submit written or electronic mail (e-mail) comments with the commenter's name and address to the address below. Only comments and hearing requests received on or before **5:00 p.m. MDT**, April 13, 2015 will be considered.

Written comments must include to the extent practicable, all referenced factual materials if such materials are not reasonably available. Documents in the Administrative Record need not be resubmitted, if expressly referenced by the commenter. Requests for a public hearing shall provide: (1) a clear and concise factual statement of the nature and scope of the interest of the person requesting the hearing; (2) the name and address of all organizations whom the requestor represents; (3) a statement of any objections to the CAC proposal, including specific references to any Permit conditions or regulations or issues being addressed; and (4) a statement of the issues which the commenter proposes to raise for consideration at the hearing. If requested, a

public hearing will be held unless all objections to the CAC proposal are withdrawn. NMED will provide a 30 day notice of a public hearing, if a hearing is held.

NMED must ensure that the final decision of this action is consistent with the New Mexico Hazardous Waste Management Regulations (20.4.1 NMAC). All written comments submitted will be considered in formulating a final decision and may cause the CAC proposal to be modified or rejected. NMED will respond in writing to all public comments received. NMED's response will specify if any modification has been made or if the proposal has been rejected, the reason for the change or rejection, and briefly describe and respond to all public comments on the CAC proposal raised during the public comment period. All persons presenting written comments or who requested notification in writing will be notified of NMED's decision by mail. The response will also be posted on the NMED website.

After consideration of all the written public comments received, and of all data, views, and arguments presented at the public hearing, if one is held, NMED may modify the CAC proposal. If NMED modifies the proposal, the Permittee shall be provided by mail a copy of the modified proposal and a detailed written statement of reasons for the modifications.

The Secretary of the New Mexico Environment Department will make the final decision publicly available and shall notify the Permittee by certified mail. The Secretary's decision shall constitute a final agency decision and may be appealed as provided by the Hazardous Waste Act (Chapter 74, Article 4 NMSA 1978).
