# NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR PUBLIC COMMENT AND PUBLIC MEETINGS ON DRAFT COMPLIANCE ORDER ON CONSENT LOS ALAMOS NATIONAL LABORATORY LOS ALAMOS, NEW MEXICO EPA ID NO. NM0890010515

Under the authority of the New Mexico Hazardous Waste Act, NMSA 1978, §§ 74-4-1 to 74-4-14, and the New Mexico Hazardous Waste Management Regulations, 20.4.1 NMAC, the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) announces release of a draft Compliance Order on Consent (Draft Consent Order) which will supersede the March 1, 2005 Compliance Order on Consent (2005 Consent Order) for Los Alamos National Laboratory.

On March 1, 2005, NMED and the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) and the Regents of the University of California entered into the 2005 Consent Order that prescribed fence-to-fence cleanup requirements for the Laboratory. Any scope of work not completed under the 2005 Consent Order will be carried forward by inclusion in the Draft Consent Order.

NMED initiated public discussion and feedback on this Draft Consent Order through presentations of the concepts and objectives of the document at the November 12, 2015 Northern New Mexico Citizen Advisory Board (NNMCAB) meeting and the November 13, 2015 Regional Coalition of Los Alamos Communities (RCLC) meeting. In addition, NMED has met with other interested stakeholders, including tribes, local governments and non-governmental organizations, since November for feedback on NMED's recommended approach to the Draft Consent Order.

NMED also announces the following opportunities for public comment:

NMED will also schedule meetings with individual stakeholders, as requested, during the 45-day public comment period of March 30, 2016 – May 16, 2016 to solicit input, address concerns, and answer questions about the Draft Consent Order.

Following the closure of the public comment period, NMED is scheduled to present at the May 18, 2016, NNMCAB Meeting at the Cities of Gold Hotel, 10-A Cities of Gold Road, Santa Fe, New Mexico from 1:00 P.M. to 5:00 P.M. This will be an opportunity for NMED to discuss the comments received during the public comment period in relation to the Draft Consent Order.
