

## STATE of NEW MEXICO STANDARDS LOG

### Important Notes:

On 5/8/87, New Mexico re-adopted all of 29 CFR 1910, as published through July 1986, with minor exceptions.

On 3/10/88, New Mexico re-adopted all of 29 CFR 1926, as published through August 31, 1986, with minor exceptions.

On 12/14/90, New Mexico re-adopted all of 29 CFR 1910, as published through September 5, 1989, with minor exceptions, and 19 CFR 1926, as published through June 1, 1989, with minor exceptions.

On 6/25/92, New Mexico re-adopted all of 29 CFR 1910, as published through December 6, 1991, with minor exceptions noted in OHSR 200.

On 4/21/95, New Mexico re-codified all OHS 200, 300, and 400, and parts of the 100 series regulations, as required by State law. General Provisions regulations are now at 11 NMAC 5.1; General Industry Standards are now at 11 NMAC 5.2; Construction Standards are now at 11 NMAC 5.3; and Agricultural Standards are now at 11 NMAC 5.4.

On 6/14/96, New Mexico re-adopted all of 29 CFR 1910, as published through July 1, 1995, with minor exceptions noted in 11 NMAC 5.2, and re-adopted 29 CFR 1926, as published through July 1, 1995, with minor exceptions noted in 11 NMAC 5.3.
