On 6/21/04, the EID submitted a petition to adopt amendments to the regulations also filed by the convenience store industry with the New Mexico Court of Appeals, which challenges adoption of the r d other issues.   a September, a second EIB hearing concerning these regulations was held. The Board directed the parties to prepare a comproposal they could all agree to, and to present it at the October 5-6 EIB hearing. At the October 5-6 EIB hearing, the Board adopt gulations. These will be transmitted to the Region once they are final (30 days after filing at the Records Center).
